BrowseAloud Plus reads website content out loud in a high quality, human-sounding voice.

Each word is highlighted as it is read aloud and the sentence is highlighted in a contrasting colour. This allows users to easily identify what text is being read aloud and navigate within and between web pages. BrowseAloud Plus is free to website visitors, there's no download and it is really easy to get.

BrowseAloud Plus Toolbar Functionality



BrowseAloud Plus delivers high quality speech to assist those with dyslexia, literacy difficulties, mild visual impairments and where English is a second language when browsing the web. BrowseAloud Plus features and options are accessed from an easy to use, floating toolbar. They include:

Play by 'Hover Highlighting'

To start speech, move your mouse pointer over the text (and click or tap the text if you are using a mobile or tablet device). BrowseAloud Plus uses dual-colour highlighting which highlights the block of text in one colour and the spoken word in another to give a clear indication of what text is being read aloud and to aid navigation. The audio-visual reinforcement also improves word recognition and comprehension.




Play by 'Text Selection'

As an alternative to Hover Highlighting, users can select specific text to hear it read aloud. Again, the text will be read out using synchronous dual-colour highlighting.



NEW Translator

Translate web pages and PDF documents into 74 languages! Speak the translated text where there is a matching voice available; currently 33 of the supported languages. Web owners can choose to have the translator switched on/off or choose to have individual languages switched on/off as desired.

Text Magnification

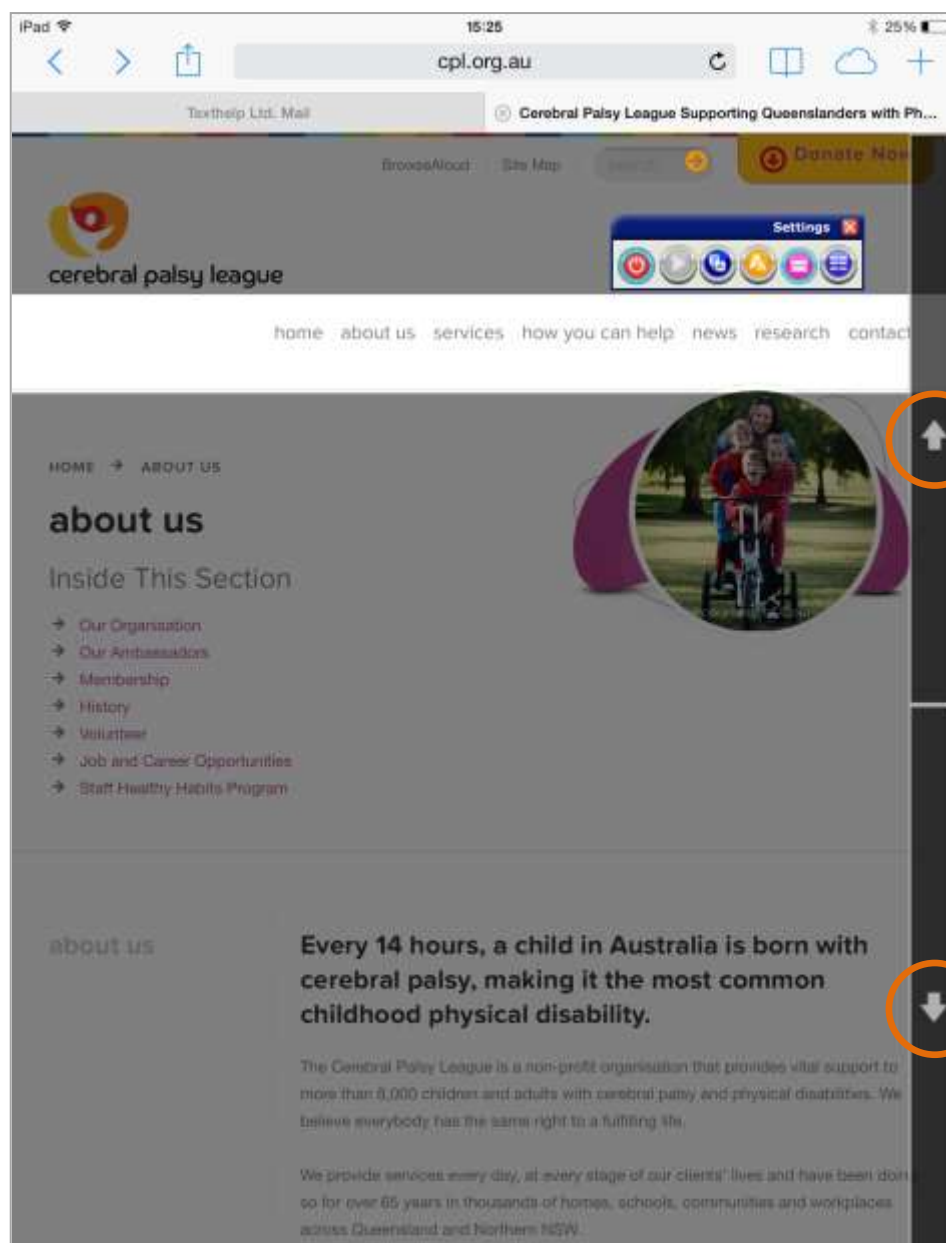
BrowseAloud Plus can magnify the text as it is read aloud. The magnified text is displayed with synchronous highlighting in a single line at the top of the screen as the text is being read aloud.



NEW Screen Mask

Block distractions on your screen with our Screen Mask. A semi-opaque black mask extends across your screen leaving a letterbox reading window clear. This helps you to focus on the section of the web page you are most interested in.

Now available on touch screen devices. The Screen Mask will move up/down in response to clicking on the clearly defined large buttons on the right hand of the screen.



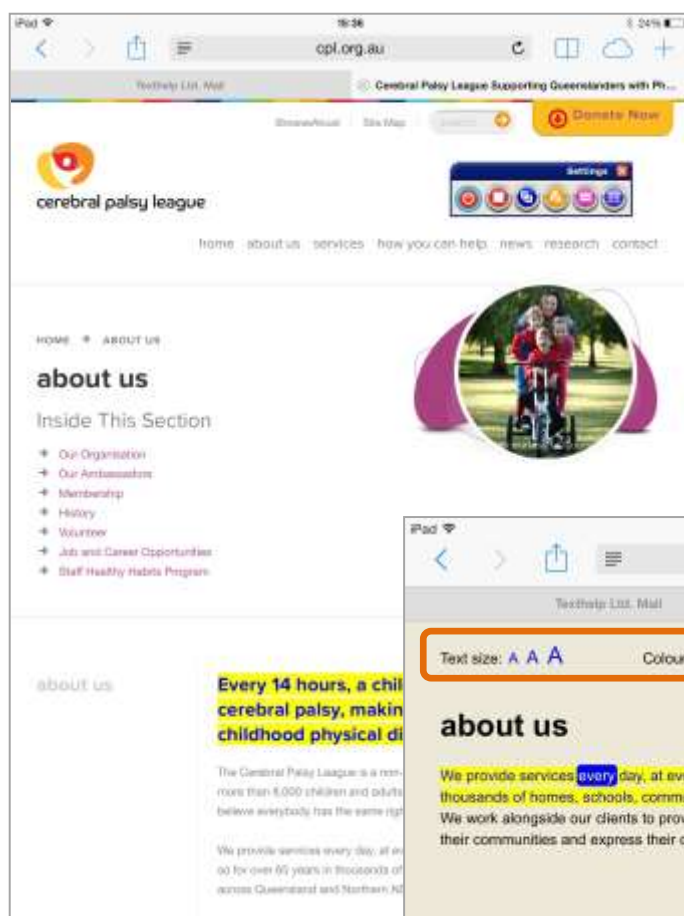

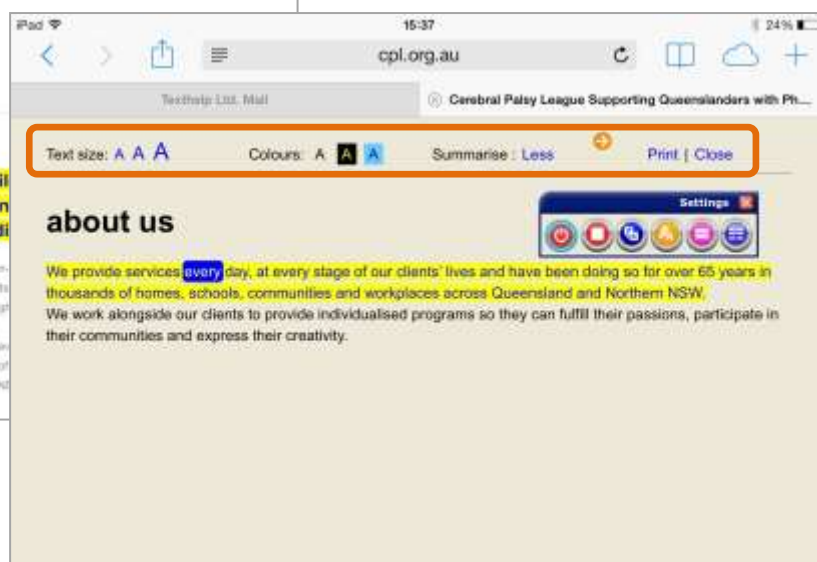
NEW Simplifier

Remove clutter from your screen with our new Simplifier. The feature presents the current web page in a more user-friendly layout that is free from the secondary information on the page. Once simplified, the text can be summarised¹, translated and printed to further help users to digest the information on the page.

Users can customise this feature to suit their individual preferences, such as: increase/decrease font size, change the colours used to highlight text and set the level of summarisation.

NEW User Settings

Users can customise BrowseAloud Plus to suit individual needs with options to alter the voice speed, highlighting colours and size of text during magnification. These individual settings can be stored by simply creating a user account with BrowseAloud, with a name and email address, and retrieved by logging in before each browsing session.

BrowseAloud Plus now supports 74 languages with the new translation tool, and speaks 33 of those languages out loud using high quality 'expressive' voices that will transform online reading experience. The expressive speech gives the voice personality for the most natural and engaging user experience possible.

PDF Reading

Using our Online PDF Reader, BrowseAloud Plus can intuitively identify and read almost any PDF document – even if the link does not end in “.PDF” - and those that are securely hosted.

Secure Site Reading

BrowseAloud Plus reads secure web pages. It does this whilst maintaining secure communication of confidential and personal information.

Pronunciation Control

BrowseAloud Plus now empowers website owners to make pronunciation changes on their own website. This feature will be useful when pronouncing place names, people names and acronyms.

Voice Control

With BrowseAloud Plus, website owners can set a default voice (and language) on individual pages of their site. This feature will be particularly useful for dual- and multi-lingual sites.
